Report of the Secretary-General

1. A number of States that are not Members of the United Nations but participate in various United Nations activities are under obligation to contribute towards the expenses of such activities, namely:

Expenses of the United Nations activities in which non-Member States participate

2. In order to give the Committee an approximate idea of the amounts that non-Member States are required to contribute, the actual expenses for 1957 of the various activities in question are given below:

3. Under Financial Regulation 5.9, the annual contributions of non-Member States are taken into account as miscellaneous income. In the assessment of the contributions of Member States, adjustment is made in respect of miscellaneous income to the amount of the appropriations approved by the General Assembly.

Rates of Assessment

4. The percentage rates at which non-Member States shall be called upon to contribute towards the 1958 expenses of the activities in which they participate, as recommended by the Committee on Contributions and approved by the General Assembly (resolution 1223 (XII) of 14 December 1957), are:
