

ASSESSMENT OF THE NEW MEMBERS (Report of the Secretary-General)

The following reply to the Secretary General's communication of 7 October 1960 has been received from the Prime Minister and Minister for Foreign Affairs of the Ivory Coast:

Abidjan, 25 October 1960

"I have the honour to acknowledge the receipt of your letter referred to above and to enclose a document entitled: 'Inventaire Economique et Social de la Côte d'Ivoire 1947-58' (Economic and Social Inventory of the Ivory Coast, 1947-58), which provides certain statistical information and, in particular, the principal economic aggregates computed for 1956.

"Work on the economic accounts for 1958 has not yet provided an accurate national income figure for that year. This figure is, however, estimated at 105,000 million francs CFA, with a 5 per cent margin of error. During the same year the population of the Ivory Coast was estimated to be 3.1 million inhabitants.

"It is impossible to provide an estimate of the national income for each of the years 1955, 1956 and 1957, as the gross data are not sufficiently detailed to permit such an analysis.
