their information.**



Joint Communiqué
on the establishment of Diplomatic relations between
the Republic of Macedonia and the Republic of Malawi

The Government of the Republic of Macedonia and the Government of the Republic of Malawi:

- Willing to promote and reinforce friendly relations between the two countries and the two people on the basis of equality, mutual respect of sovereignty, independence, territorial integrity and non-interference in each other States' internal affairs;
- Guided by the Principles and Purposes of the Charter of the United Nations and the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of April 18, 1961;

Have decided to establish diplomatic relations at Ambassadorial level with effect from the date of signature of the present Joint Communiqué.

In witness whereof, Their Excellencies the Ministers of Foreign Affairs, duly mandated by their respective Governments have signed this Joint Communiqué in Macedonian and English, all texts being equally authentic.
