**JOINT COMMUNIQUE
ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS
BETWEEN TURKMENISTAN AND THE REPUBLIC OF UGANDA**

The Government of Turkmenistan and
the Government of the Republic of Uganda,

Guided by the mutual willingness to develop friendship and co-operation between the two States in political, trade, economic and other fields,

Have decided, based on the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 1961, to establish diplomatic relations at Ambassadorial level as of the date of the signing of this Joint Communique.

The relations between the two States will be based on the principles and norms of the Charter of the United Nations and international law, particularly, equality, respect for independence, national sovereignty, territorial integrity and non-interference in the internal affairs of the States.

In witness thereof, the undersigned, duly authorized by their respective Governments, have signed this Communique in English and Turkmen languages, both texts being equally authentic.


