LETTER DATED 21 JULY 1992 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE
OF VENEZUELA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE
SECRETARY-GENERAL

On instructions from my Government, I have the honour to inform you that the Republic of Venezuela has taken the necessary measures to implement Security Council resolution 757 (1992) imposing sanctions on the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia.

By means of an official announcement from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs dated 10 July 1992, the Government of Venezuela has notified all individuals and legal persons who are nationals of the Republic of Venezuela or domiciled therein of the scope of the measures provided for in Security Council resolution 757 (1992) and of their obligatory nature under the Charter of the United Nations. At the same time they were notified of their obligation to declare any assets held in the Republic of Venezuela by the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

Venezuela will report in due course on the measures taken to reduce the diplomatic staff of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia accredited to Venezuela.

I should be grateful if you would have this letter circulated as a document of the Security Council.
