## JOINT COMMUNIQUE ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS BETWEEN THE REPUBLIC OF CROATIA AND THE INDEPENDENT STATE OF PAPUA NEW GUINEA

The Government of the Republic of Croatia and the Government of the Independent State of Papua New Guinea, guided by the common interests and the desire by both countries to promote and strengthen relations of friendship and co-operation, have decided to establish diplomatic relations and agreed to exchange Representatives at Ambassadorial level at a date to be agreed.

In establishing diplomatic relations, both Governments agreed to re-affirm their support and commitment to international law with respect to non-interference in internal affairs of States and respect for the sovereignty and independence of States and will co-operate in the mutual endeavour to strengthen international peace and security.

Both Governments also expressed their confidence that this Agreement will contribute to increased dialogue between the two countries on issues of common interest, as well as facilitate the exploration of new areas of co-operation.

Done at New York on 05 December 1997, in two original copies, each in Croatian and English languages, both texts being equally authentic.
