## NEW ZEALAND: SUPPLEMENTARY NOTE

- 1. The New Zealand authorities have just learned that the New Zealand assessed share of costs of the budget (Part I General Expenditure) of the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) has been reduced from 0.48 per cent in 1976 to 0.44 per cent in 1977.
- 2. OECD operates on a "capacity to pay" principle, based principally on measurement of GNP at factor cost less a deduction of 10 per cent for depreciation. The 1977 assessments were derived from data for the three years 1973-75. GNP figures are converted into United States dollars according to the average current official exchange rate for those years. No country's assessment is less than 0.1 per cent or more than 25 per cent of the total.
- 3. The New Zealand authorities believe that the reduction in New Zealand's assessed contribution to the 1977 OFCD budget provides objective confirmation of the considerations affecting New Zealand's reduced "capacity to pay" that have been drawn to the attention of the United Nations Committee on Contributions.

### NATIONAL INCOME AND EXPENDITURE 1975/76

The estimated gross national product for the year ended 31 March 1976 was \$10,791 million stated the Government Statistician.

This represents an increase of 14.8 per cent over the previous year's estimate of \$9,396 million. The gross domestic product in current prices was \$11,029 million, an increase of 15.8 per cent, while the same aggregate in constant prices rose by 1.9 per cent. The attached tables give estimates of the various aggregates for 1975/76 together with revised figures for the previous three years.
