BHUTAN (continued)

There is no official information and hardly any unofficial information about the national product of the country. The World Bank Atlas: Population, Per Capita Product and Growth Rates published by the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development in 1969 mentions a tentative figure of \$60 per capita national product for 1967. This per capita estimate was multiplied by a mid-1967 population estimate of 750,000 to obtain the total net national product estimate for the country.
