Excellency,

We have the honor to inform you that the Governments of Brazil and of the Principality of Andorra, in order to ensure greater development of friendly relations between them, to promote cooperation in areas of common interest for the benefit of the two countries, to act jointly in support of peace in the international community, in accordance with the purposes and the principles established in the United Nations Charter and with reference to the relevant provisions of the Vienna Conventions that regulate diplomatic and consular relations between States, have decided to establish, as from today, diplomatic and consular relations between them.

We have the honor, further, to request that this information be transmitted to the Permanent Missions of all Member States of the United Nations.

We take this opportunity to renew to Your Excellency the assurances of our highest consideration.

**JOINT COMMUNIQUÉ
ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC AND CONSULAR RELATIONS
BETWEEN BRAZIL AND THE PRINCIPALITY OF ANDORRA**

The Governments of Brazil and of the Principality of Andorra, convinced that the best way to strengthen peace and international security is through understanding, cooperation and friendly relations between nations, have decided to establish diplomatic and consular relations, effective as of today, in accordance with the principles and purposes of the United Nations Charter and the relevant provisions of the Vienna Convention that regulate these relations.

Both governments express their confidence that this agreement will contribute to the strengthening of mutual cooperation in the areas of common interest for the benefit of both countries, which share the same objectives and goals of promoting peace and democracy.
