Mr. Daniels: Proposed resolution on the prevention of discrimination

The Sub-Commission on the Prevention of Discrimination and the Protection of Minorities,

Considering the need for precise information on efforts being made to prevent discrimination,

Recommends that the Commission on Human Rights request the Secretary-General:
(1) to invite each Member Government to furnish him, prior to 1 September 1950, examples (with appropriate citations where possible) of legislation, judicial decisions, and other methods which have been found to be especially useful in that country in preventing discrimination, in one or more of the fields covered by the Universal Declaration of Human Rights; and (2) to distribute a brief summary of that material to the members of the Sub-Commission prior to its fourth session.
