Letter dated 30 October 1987 from the Permanent Representative of  
Pakistan to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

Further to my letter dated 19 October 1987 (A/42/671-S/19223), I have the honour to report to you the following serious incidents in violation of Pakistan territory from the Afghanistan side, which occurred on 19 and 22 October 1987:

On 19 October 1987, between 1125 and 1220 hours, Afghan armed forces fired 8 rounds of artillery, which landed in the Teri Mangel area in the Kurram Agency. As a result, three Afghan refugees were injured.

On 22 October 1987, between 1300 and 1420 hours, Afghan armed forces fired 10 rounds of mortar and approximately 300 rounds of anti-aircraft machine-gun, which landed in the Arandu area in the Chitral District. As a result, one civilian (Pakistan national) was injured.

The Afghan Chargé d'affaires was summoned to the Foreign Office at Islamabad on the morning of 25 October 1987 and on 28 October 1987, and a strong protest was lodged with him over the unprovoked attacks. He was asked to inform his authorities that if such attacks did not cease the entire responsibility for the serious consequences would rest on the Kabul authorities.

I request you to have this letter circulated as a document of the General Assembly, under agenda items 31, 72, 129, 134 and 138, and of the Security Council.
