India-Pakistan agreement on minorities

(Note by the Secretariat)

The statement of the late Prime Minister of Pakistan, Mr. Liaquat Ali Khan, quoted at the end of paragraph 6, should read as follows:

"I look upon this agreement as a precursor of a new understanding between India and Pakistan.... At the same time, a most important principle has been re-emphasized, that the allegiance and loyalty of the minorities is to the State of which they are citizens and it is to the Government of their own State that they should look for the redress of their grievances. The reiteration of this concept has been found to be necessary because much political and communal mischief in both countries is the result of a failure to recognize this basic principle."
