JOINT COMMUNIQUE ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENTS OF THE REPUBLIC OF MACEDONIA AND

THE LAO PEOPLE'S DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC

The Governments of the Republic of Macedonia and the Lao People's Democratic Republic, guided by mutual willingness to promote the relations of friendship between the two countries and to widen horizons and areas of cooperation on the basis of principles of mutual respect of their sovereignty, equality and non-interference as enshrined in the Charter of the United Nations, have agreed to establish diplomatic relations at the Ambassadorial level, based on the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 1961.

Both Governments further agreed to open their diplomatic Mission at a time convenient to and agreed upon by the two countries.

In witness whereof, the undersigned being duly authorized by their respective Governments have signed the present Joint Communiqué..

Done in New York on March 6, 1996 in duplicate, each in English and Macedonian, both texts being equally authentic.
