JOINT COMMUNIQUE
ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS
BETWEEN
THE CZECH REPUBLIC AND THE COMMONWEALTH OF DOMINICA

The Government of the Czech Republic and the Government of the Commonwealth of Dominica, desirous of developing and strengthening relations between the two countries in the interest of peace and cooperation among peoples and on the basis of mutual respect for independence, sovereignty and territorial integrity, as well as on the principles of non-interference, non-use of force in international relations, peaceful settlement of disputes and other principles enshrined in the Charter of the United Nations, have agreed to establish diplomatic relations between the two countries as from the date of signature of this Joint Communiqué.

Both Governments have decided to designate, at a time convenient to both countries, their respective representatives at the level of Ambassadors and, as a first step, on a non-resident basis.
