**JOINT STATEMENT
ON THE
ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS
BETWEEN THE REPUBLIC OF MACEDONIA AND THE
PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF BANGLADESH**

The Republic of Macedonia and the People's Republic of Bangladesh,

Guided by mutual willingness to promote the relations of friendship, between the two countries and to widen horizons and areas of cooperation in the political, economic, cultural, humanitarian and other fields,

Intending to develop these relations on the basis of the Charter of the United Nations and international law,

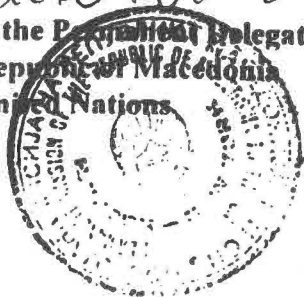
Have agreed to establish diplomatic relations at the Ambassadorial level, based on the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 1961.

The People's Republic of Bangladesh and the Republic of Macedonia believe that the establishment of diplomatic relations will help to foster further development of close and friendly relations between the two Governments and their peoples.
