THE FUTURE ORGANIZATION AND TERMS OF REFERENCE OF THE  
ECONOMIC AND EMPLOYMENT COMMISSION AND ITS SUB-COMMISSIONS

Additional communications received from Member Governments:

- A. Iraq. The Ministry of Foreign Affairs has the honour to state that the Iraqi competent authorities have no comments to make on the resolution of the Economic and Social Council regarding the future of the Economic and Employment Commission of the Council and its Sub-Commissions.
- B. Luxembourg. The resolutions and recommendations adopted by the United Nations Economic and Social Council and contained in document E/CN.1/62 call for no comment by the Government of the Grand Duchy, which fully agrees with the principle underlying the aims pursued.

The work, more particularly on problems of employment, to which - should one of its experts be called into consultation by the Council - the Grand Duchy might make its contribution, is that entrusted to the Sub-Commission on Employment and Economic Stability. It may be summarized as follows:

- (a) Survey, on the national and international levels, of the policy to be adopted to bring about full employment, study of the fluctuations of economic activity, investigation and analysis of the causes of such fluctuations;
- (b) Recommendations to be submitted to the Council - if necessary in collaboration with the Sub-Commission on Balance of Payments and other bodies - on the most appropriate ways of securing full employment and economic stability.
