


**JOINT COMMUNIQUE
ON THE
ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS
BETWEEN THE REPUBLIC OF MACEDONIA AND
THE KINGDOM OF CAMBODIA**

The Government of the Republic of Macedonia and the Government of the Kingdom of Cambodia, guided by mutual desire to develop friendship and cooperation in the political, economic and cultural fields, on the basis of the principles of the Charter of the United Nations, the norms of peaceful coexistence, equality and mutual respect for the sovereignty and the territorial integrity of each and the principle of non-interference in their internal affairs, have decided to establish diplomatic relations at the ambassadorial level, as of 29 October 1996, in accordance with the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 1961.


The Government of the Republic of Macedonia and the Government of the Kingdom of Cambodia express their confidence that the establishment of diplomatic relations will contribute to the enhancement of international cooperation and the preservation of world peace.

Done in the City of New York, on 29 October 1996, in three equally authentic texts in the English, Macedonian, and Khmer languages, whereas all copies have equal force.
