
Excellency,

JOINT COMMUNIQUE
ON ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS BETWEEN
THE DEMOCRATIC PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF KOREA AND
THE REPUBLIC OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

The Government of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea and the Government of the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina desirous of developing relations of friendship and cooperation in compliance with ideal of independence, peace and friendship have agreed to the establishment of diplomatic relations and exchange of diplomatic representatives at ambassadorial level between the two countries in accordance with the Charter of the United Nations and accepted principles of international law.
