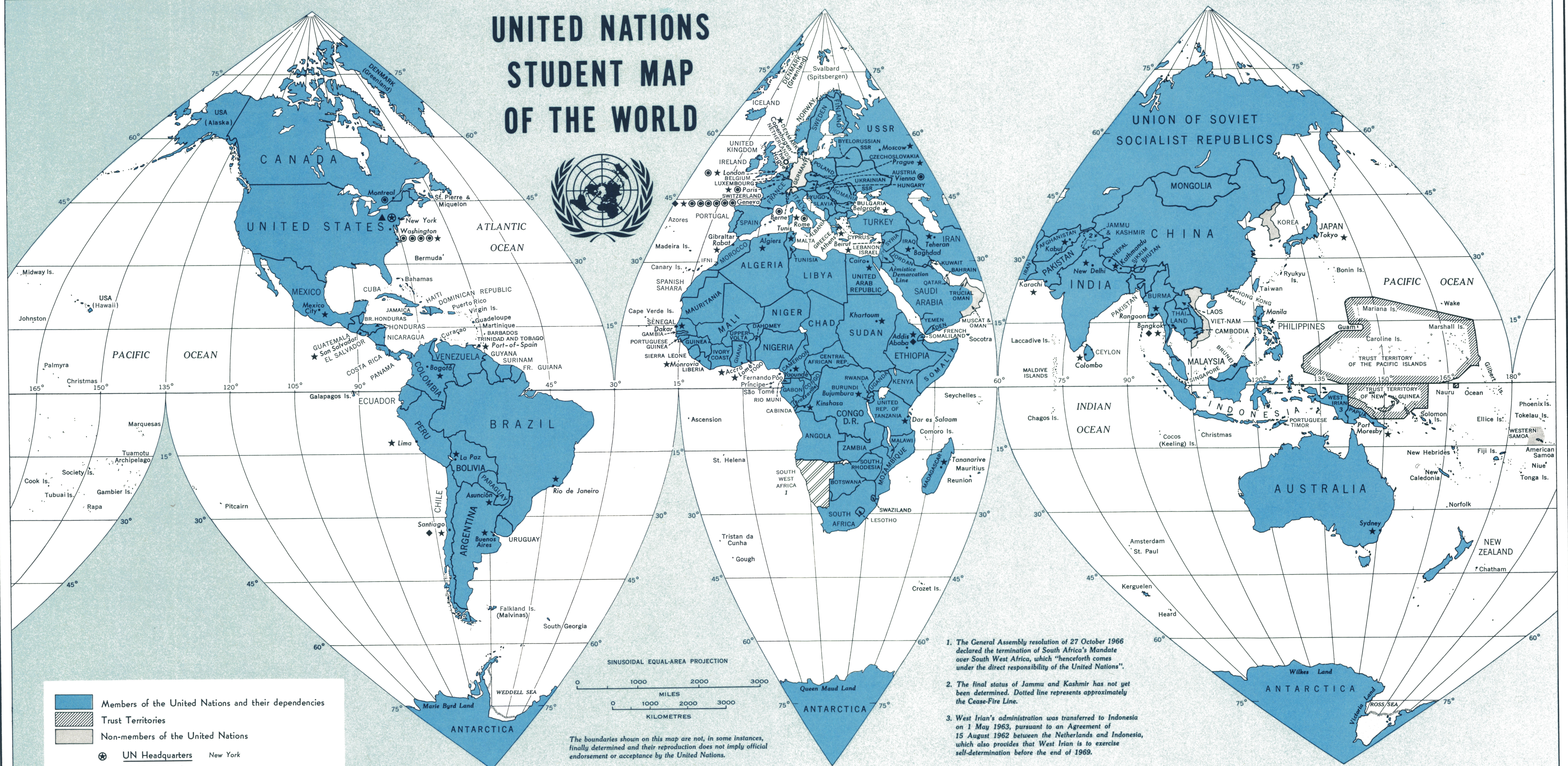


UNITED NATIONS STUDENT MAP OF THE WORLD

- West Iran's administration was transferred to Indonesia on 1 May 1963, pursuant to an Agreement of 15 August 1962 between the Netherlands and Indonesia, which also provides that West Iran is to exercise self-determination before the end of 1969.
