## ORGANIZATION OF THE FUTURE WORK OF THE CONHHRENCE

The CHAIRMAN, after describing the progress made in the work of the Conference, invited representatives to express their views on ita future proceedings.

Mr. VAILI (France) recalled that the conmittee had decided that article 7 of the protocol (Definitions) would be submitted to the Conference directiy. He propoeed that the Final Act, which was not legally binding on the parties, should also be submitted directly to the Conference.

Mr. NIKOLIC (Yugoslavia) hoped that the procedure for examining the Final Act or the definitiona contained in the protocol would be lesa atrict than that followed in the consideration of the draft protocol iteelf.

Mr. WALKER (United Kinguon) eupported the French representative's proposal ooncerning the Final tot. He acked that representatives ahould be given twenty-four hours in which to study the new draft of the protocol.

The CHAIRMAN explained that it would be for the Conference to decide whether it agreed to eimplify ite procedure for coneidering the Final Act or the definitions inserted in article 7 of the protocol. He hoped that the Business Comittee would be able to meet the United Kingdom representative 's wishes regarding a period of twonty-four hours to study the nev draft of the protocol.
