LIMITATION OF PRODUCTION OF RAW MATERIALS
FURTHER REPLIES BY GOVERNMENTS ON THE QUESTIONNAIRE ON OPIUM

Note by the Secretary-General

The Secretary-General has the honour to communicate to the members of the Commission on Narcotic Drugs the reply of the Government of Pakistan to the questionnaire on the limitation and control of the cultivation of the opium poppy and the production of raw opium (E/CN.7/63). For previous replies, see documents E/CN.7/107 with addenda 1-6 and E/CN.7/190.

"Pakistan (June 2, 1949)

"The questionnaire on raw opium prepared by the Commission on Narcotic Drugs (document E/251/Add.2) was received by the Government of undivided India by whom a reply was to be sent before the date of the partition of India. No reply by the Government of Pakistan was therefore necessary. Moreover, at present, no opium is produced and no alkaloids are manufactured in Pakistan."
