CORRIGENDUM TO THE SUMMARY RECORD OF THE EIGHTY-FIFTH MEETING

Held at Lake Success, New York,
on Thursday, 12 May 1949, at 3.15 p.m.

Page 3, lines 7 - 9

Delete "Indeed, respect for ... among nations", and substitute:

"In accordance with Article 55 of the Charter, respect for human rights was only a means towards the achievement of the aim, but the aim was 'peaceful and friendly relations among nations based on respect for the principle of equal rights and self-determination of peoples', the words 'equal rights and self-determination of peoples' being of extreme importance."
