1. Libya, with the assistance of the United Nations, was established as an independent and sovereign State on 24 December 1951.
2. Eritrea, with the assistance of the United Nations, was federated with Ethiopia as an autonomous unit under the sovereignty of the Ethiopian Crown on 11 September 1952.
3. The Territory of South West Africa is under the Administration of the Union of South Africa by virtue of a mandate of the former League of Nations.
4. The delineation of the boundaries of the State of Israel has not yet been finally determined.
5. Viet-Nam, Laos and Cambodia, in South-East Asia, enjoy a special status within the French Union and have requested admission into the United Nations.
6. The status of French Morocco and Tunisia, in North Africa, is now under consideration by France.
7. The final status of Jammu and Kashmir has not yet been determined.
8. As of 5 June 1953, Greenland has become a province of Denmark.
