ORGANIZATION OF THE SESSION

1. The Committee for Programme and Coordination (CPC) held an organizational session (1st and 2nd meetings) at United Nations Headquarters on 8 April and 5 May 1993 and the first part of its thirty-third session at United Nations Headquarters from 10 to 14 May. It held _____ meetings (3rd-___ meetings) and a number of informal meetings.
