CORRIGENDUM

The eighth paragraph should read as follows:

With regard to China, the representative of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics proposed that the credentials of the representatives of the National Government of China should not be recognized as valid.

The ninth paragraph should read as follows:

By 6 votes to 2, with 1 abstention, the Committee rejected this proposal in view of the General Assembly's resolution of 19 September 1950 which stated that, pending a decision by the General Assembly on the report of its Special Committee, the representatives of the National Government of China should be seated in the General Assembly with the same rights as the other representatives.
