

Excellency,



**JOINT COMMUNIQUE ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC
RELATIONS BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE LAO PEOPLE'S
DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC AND THE FEDERATIVE REPUBLIC OF BRAZIL.**


The Governments of the Lao People's Democratic Republic and the Federative Republic of Brazil, desirous of promoting and strengthening the relations between the two countries and determined to promote cooperation in mutual interests, have decided to establish relations at the Ambassadorial level on the basis of the principles of mutual respect of their sovereignty, equality and non-interference, as enshrined in the Charter of the United Nations.

Both Governments further agreed to open their diplomatic Missions at a time convenient to and agreed upon by the two countries


In witness whereof, the undersigned being duly authorized by their respective Governments have signed and sealed the present Joint Communique.
