**NOTES**

1. Libya, with the assistance of the United Nations, is to become independent by 1 January 1952. Somaliland is to become a Trust Territory under Italian Administration for ten years. The disposal of Eritrea is to be determined by the General Assembly of the United Nations.
2. The Mandated Territory of South-West Africa is administered by the Union of South Africa.
3. The delineation of the boundaries of the State of Israel has not yet been finally determined.
4. Indonesia became independent on 27 December 1949 and a Member of the United Nations on 28 September 1950.
5. French Morocco, Tunisia and Indochina are Associated States within the French Union. Algeria, Reunion and the three French Caribbean territories form the Group of Overseas Departments which juridically are Departments of France.
6. The final status of Jammu and Kashmir has not yet been determined.
