LETTER DATED 7 AUGUST 1992 FROM THE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES A.I.
OF THE PERMANENT MISSION OF BELGIUM TO THE UNITED NATIONS
ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

My Government is deeply alarmed at the repression being suffered by the civilian population of Iraq, as detailed in the interim report on the human rights situation in Iraq prepared by Mr. Max van der Stoel, a report which, in my letter of 3 August 1992 (S/24386), I requested you to have circulated as a document of the Security Council.

The Security Council having, in its resolution 688 (1991) and the presidential statement of 11 March 1992, undertaken to keep the question of repression in Iraq under review, I have the honour, on behalf of my Government, to request the convening of an urgent meeting of the Council.

It is my belief that the work of the Security Council would benefit immensely from the presence of Mr. van der Stoel, who the Council should invite under rule 39 of its provisional rules of procedure.
