## Paragraph 2 (bis)

Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph 2, Members may enter into agreements with Non-Members, according to paragraphs 3, 4, 5 and 6 of Article 15, and paragraphs 2, 3, 5 and 6 of Article 42B;

provided that such Non-Members undertake in the agreements the same obligations established in those articles for the Members.

The purpose of this amendment is to make possible the conclusion of preferential agreements, customs union and free trade areas between Members and Non-Members, because the relevant articles of the Charter refer only to Members. It is to be underlined that under this amendment Non-Members undertake the same obligations as Members to comple with the provisions of Articles 15 and 42.
