NOTE TO HEADS OF DELEGATIONS

1. The Mayor of Havana wishes to express to the delegations represented at the United Nations Conference on Trade and Employment the city's appreciation of the fact that the Charter of the International Trade Organization has been named "The Charter of Havana".
2. As a token of the city's appreciation the Mayor wishes to present to the heads of delegations and to the delegates who approved Article 100 of the Charter in the Sixth Committee, an etching of Havana with a personal dedication signed by the Mayor. The presentation ceremony would take place on Saturday, 20 March, or on the day of the signing of the Charter, either in the Palacio Municipal or in the Capitol as may be most convenient.
3. For this purpose, a list is required of the delegations represented at the Conference, together with the names of heads of delegations and of the delegates, other than heads of delegations, who voted for the name "The Charter of Havana" at the meeting of the Sixth Committee held on 19 February 1948, (document E/CONF.2/C.6/SR.29)
4. Heads of delegations are therefore requested to transmit to the Executive Secretary by Wednesday, 17 March at noon, the names of the delegates to whom paragraph 3 above refers.
