Draft Resolution submitted by the Representative of
the International Transport Workers' Federation

The United Nations Conference on Road and Motor Transport,
meeting in Geneva August-September 1949,

CONSIDERING that in the interest of greater road safety,
measures should be taken to bring about uniformity in the conditions
of employment of workers engaged in long-distance motor road
transport;

REQUESTS the Economic and Social Council to invite the
Governing Body of the International Labour Office to consider the
possibility of putting on the agenda of an early Session of the
International Labour Conference the question of conditions of
employment of drivers and helpers engaged in long-distance motor road
transport, within Europe, and if necessary and possible, also within
other parts of the World, with a view to the adoption of an
international Convention.
