IMPLEMENTATION OF THE DECLARATION ON THE GRANYING OF INDEPENDENCE TO COLONIAL COUNTRIES AND PEOPLES

Letter dated 9 November 1987 from the Permanent Representative of Sweden to the United Nations addressed to the President of the General Assembly

Upon instructions from my Government, I have the honour to inform you that Sweden has decided to relinquish its membership in the Special Committee on the Situation with regard to the Implementation of the Declaration on the Granting of Independence to Colonial Countries and Peoples as of 31 December 1987.

Sweden is withdrawing from the Committee in accordance with an established practice of rotation among the three Nordic countries, Denmark, Norway and Sweden. I have been informed by the Permanent Representative of Norway that his country is prepared to replace Sweden in the Committee as of the above date.
