TENTH PLENARY MEETING

CORRIGENDUM TO SUMMARY RECORD

On Page 3, 2nd paragraph, the last sentence of the statement by Mr. JEFFES (United Kingdom) should read:

"It was realised that an applicant for a transit visa, as well as an applicant for an ordinary visa, might be subject to certain security examination, but, apart from that, his delegation felt that, provided the traveller was able to assure authorities he was able to reach his ultimate destination, a transit visa should be granted to him practically automatically."

On Page 11, third paragraph, the last sentence of the statement by the CHAIRMAN should read:

"A simple landing card was also used, but for record and for statistical purposes".

On Page 13, first paragraph, the statement by the Chairman should read:

"The CHAIRMAN reiterated the opinion already expressed that discussion of a special type of passenger card did not seem useful at the moment and expressed doubt whether the suggestion made by the representative of ICAO that landing cards or similar documents should be uniform was practicable."
