MEMORANDUM:
DANISH REGULATIONS REGARDING PASSPORTS, VISAS,
AND FRONTIER FORMALITIES

Page 19:

Delete in the sentence "ad II) Frontier Formalities (Police Control)" the words "(Police Control)"

Insert after this sentence the following:

"In General

In Denmark the control of passports, luggage, and currency is carried out in immediate succession, and so far as possible, during the course of a journey.

A. Police Control "

Page 21:

At the end, insert the following:

"B. Currency Control

Foreign exchange in notes and coins may freely be imported into Denmark, whereas export may only take place with permission from the National Bank of Denmark. At the arrival in Denmark, however, not only transit passengers, but all travellers who are domiciled abroad can have an import-certificate issued by the customs authorities, which certificate at the departure entitles them to re-export the same amount in foreign exchange as imported without the necessity of obtaining permission from the National Bank.

Purchase and sale of foreign currency may only be effected through the National Bank or an authorized dealer in foreign exchange.

Import and export of Danish Kroner in notes and coin may only take place with the consent of the National Bank of Denmark. Each traveller may, however, without obtaining permission from the National Bank carry up to Kroner 2000,00 in 10 Kr. notes, 5 Kr. notes and coin. For travellers to and from Sweden, Norway and

Finland the free limit is however only 25 Kr. If a traveller brings with him amounts of Danish currency at the arrival in excess of the limits mentioned above, such amounts may be deposited at the frontier (with the customs authorities) against a certificate in favour of the traveller, redeemable by him at any place of exit from Denmark.

Travellers cheques and letters of credit may freely be imported and exported. This rule applies whether they are payable in Danish Kroner or in foreign currency.

C. Customs inspection of luggage

Notices stating restrictions in force concerning import and export of commodities as well as such articles, usually carried by travellers, which are liable to duty, are posted in customs houses, trains, etc.

Written declarations concerning ordinary luggage are not demanded by customs authorities.

Registered luggage in transit and luggage of passengers in transit by air is exempted from customs examination.

Customs examination of registered luggage will, when possible, take place at the place of arrival."
