The enclosed communication dated 16 May 1977 is transmitted to the Permanent Missions of the States Members of the United Nations at the request of the representatives of Grenada and Thailand to the United Nations.

Excellency:

We have the honour to inform Your Excellency that today our respective Governments have simultaneously made public a Joint Communique on the establishment of diplomatic relations between them, the text of which reads as follows:

"The Government of Grenada and the Government of Thailand, desirous of strengthening the friendship which exists between both nations and of consolidating and intensifying cooperation in the fields of politics, commerce and culture, have decided to establish with immediate effect diplomatic relations at Ambassadorial level and to accredit in due course non-resident Ambassadors to their respective countries."

We have the honour to request Your Excellency to kindly circulate the above text to all Permanent Missions and Offices of Permanent Observers to the United Nations and take this opportunity to renew to Your Excellency the assurances of our highest consideration.
