COMMUNIQUE CONCERNING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS BETWEEN THE REPUBLIC OF THE IVORY COAST AND THE REPUBLIC OF GUINEA

Government of the Republic of the Ivory Coast

and

Government of the Republic of Guinea,

Being firmly resolved to implement the decisions of the Monrovia Summit Conference and 19 March 1978,

Conscious of the historical, geographical, political, economic and human ties exist between the peoples of the Ivory Coast and Guinea,

pesiring to strengthen the ties of friendship and brotherhood between their oples and to develop co-operation between their two countries on the basis of the inciples of equality, tolerance, mutual respect, territorial integrity, interference in the internal affairs of other States and peaceful settlement disputes,

Have decided to establish diplomatic relations at the ambassadorial level and exchange ambassadors as soon as possible.
