President: 

In the absence of the President, Mrs. Pobee Reports of the Fifth Committee (Ghana), Vice-President, took the Chair.

Draft resolution (A/72/L.40)

Report of the Fifth Committee (A/72/811)

The Acting President: The Assembly will now take a decision on draft resolution A/72/L.40, entitled "Scope, modalities, format and organization of the high-level meeting on the fight against tuberculosis". May I take it that the Assembly decides to adopt the draft resolution?

Draft resolution A/72/L.40 was adopted (resolution 72/268).

The Acting President: I would like to express my sincere thanks to Ambassador Walton Alfonso Webson of Antigua and Barbuda and Ambassador Koro Bessho of Japan, the co-facilitators of the informal consultations, who demonstrated great ability and patience in their conduct of the discussion and complex negotiations on the draft resolution. I also thank Member States for their valuable contributions to reaching an agreement on resolution 72/268.

The General Assembly has thus concluded this stage of its consideration of agenda item 127.

The President: The General Assembly will now consider the reports of the Fifth Committee on agenda items 136, 142, 148 and 134.

I request the Rapporteur of the Fifth Committee, Mr. Felipe García Landa of Mexico, to introduce in one intervention the reports of the Fifth Committee before the Assembly.

Mr. García Landa (Mexico), Rapporteur of the Fifth Committee (spoke in Spanish): I have the honour to introduce to the General Assembly the reports of the Fifth Committee containing recommendations on issues considered during the first part of the resumed seventy-second session of the General Assembly. The Fifth Committee met from 14 to 29 March and held five plenary meetings, as well as numerous informal consultations.

Let me now present the reports of the Fifth Committee, containing recommendations on issues that require action by the General Assembly.

Under agenda item 136, "Programme budget for the biennium 2018-2019", the Committee provides advice to the General Assembly on programme budget implications should it adopt draft resolution A/72/L.40. The relevant report of the Fifth Committee is contained in document A/72/811.

Under the same agenda item, in paragraph 6 of its report contained in document A/72/681/Add.1, the Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of a draft resolution on special subjects relating

to the programme budget for the biennium 2018-2019, which was adopted by the Committee without a vote.

Under agenda item 142, "Joint Inspection Unit", in paragraph 6 of its report contained in document A/72/810, the Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of a draft resolution that was adopted by the Committee without a vote.

On agenda item 148, "Financing of the International Residual Mechanism for Criminal Tribunals", in paragraph 6 of its report contained in document A/72/669/Add.1, the Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of a draft resolution that was adopted by the Committee without a vote.

Finally, on agenda item 134, "Review of the efficiency of the administrative and financial functioning of the United Nations", in paragraph 5 of its report contained in document A/72/682/Add.1, the Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of a draft decision entitled "Questions deferred for future consideration", which was adopted by the Committee without a vote.

I thank delegations for their cooperation during this session and for the spirit of compromise that enabled the Committee to finish its work on time.

I would also like to thank the Chair of the Committee, Ambassador Tommo Monthe, for his guidance and encouragement. I look forward to working with him and my colleagues of the Bureau to ensure the success of the second part of the resumed session, which will take place in May, the agenda of which includes issues of great importance to the Organization.

**The Acting President**: I thank the Rapporteur of the Fifth Committee.

The positions of delegations regarding the recommendations of the Fifth Committee have been made clear in the Committee and are reflected in the relevant official records.

If there is no proposal under rule 66 of the rules of procedure, I shall take it that the General Assembly decides not to discuss the reports of the Fifth Committee that are before the Assembly today.

**The Acting President**: Statements will therefore be limited to explanations of vote.

May I remind members that, under paragraph 7 of decision 34/401, the General Assembly agreed that:

"When the same draft resolution is considered in a Main Committee and in plenary meeting, a delegation should, as far as possible, explain its vote only once, i.e., either in the Committee or in plenary meeting, unless that delegation's vote in plenary meeting is different from its vote in the Committee."

May I further remind delegations that, also in accordance with General Assembly decision 34/401, explanations of vote are limited to 10 minutes and should be made by delegations from their seats.

Before we begin to take action on the recommendations contained in the reports of the Fifth Committee, I should like to advise representatives that we are going to proceed to take decisions in the same manner as was done in the Committee, unless the Secretariat is notified to the contrary in advance. That means that, where recorded votes were taken, we will do the same. I also hope that we may proceed to adopt without a vote those recommendations that were adopted without a vote in the Fifth Committee.
