LETTER DATED 13 AUGUST 1992 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF THE COMOROS TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

In view of the deteriorating situation in Bosnia-Herzegovina involving very serious violations of human rights and international law, abetted by acts of interference and armed intervention by a foreign country, threatening international peace and security, I have the honour to request, on behalf of the Government of Comoros, an urgent meeting of the Security Council, with formal debate, to consider the situation there and take appropriate collective action including measures provided under Article 42, Chapter VII, of the United Nations Charter to restore peace and stability in the region.

I would be grateful if the text of this letter could be circulated as a document of the Security Council.
