
We have the honour to inform Your Excellency that our respective governments simultaneously published a Joint Communiqué on 18 January 1979 concerning the establishment of diplomatic relations between our two countries the text of which is as follows:

"The Socialist People's Libyan Arab Jamahir-
iya and Haiti in accordance with the interests and
the will of their two peoples have jointly decided
to establish diplomatic relations on the ambassa-
dorial level with effect from 18 January 1979 at
12:00 GMT.

The countries have agreed to promote friendly
relations and co-operation between their peoples on
the basis of the principles of mutual respect for
their sovereignty and territorial integrity of mu-
tual non-interference in their internal affairs and
of equality and mutual benefits."
