Sir,

We have the honour to inform you that on 31 May 1979 the Government of the Republic of Cuba and the Government of the Republic of Suriname issued a joint communiqué concerning the establishment of diplomatic relations between the two countries, the text of which is as follows:

"The Government of the Republic of Cuba and the Government of the Republic of Suriname, desiring to develop the relations of friendship and co-operation between their peoples and acting in accordance with the principles set out in the Charter of the United Nations, have decided to establish diplomatic relations as from 31 May 1979.

"Signed: Raúl Roa Kourí, Ambassador, Permanent Representative of Cuba to the United Nations.

"Signed: Henricus A. F. Heidweiller, Ambassador, Permanent Representative of the Republic of Suriname to the United Nations."

We should be grateful if you would transmit this communication to Member States and Permanent Observers to the United Nations, and we take this opportunity to renew to you the assurances of our highest consideration.
