

JOINT COMMUNIQUE

With a view to strengthening the ties of friendship and cooperation which exist between the Peoples and Governments of Grenada and The Democratic Republic of Sao Tome and Principe;

On the basis of the mutual respect for independence, sovereignty, territorial integrity and the principle of non-interference in each other's country's internal affairs, in accordance with the principles laid down in the charter of the United Nations;

The People's Revolutionary Government of Grenada and the Government of the Democratic Republic of Sao Tome and Principe have agreed to establish diplomatic relations between the two countries at the Ambassadorial level effective November 23rd, 1979.
