The Government of the People's Republic of Bulgaria and the Government of the Democratic Republic of Sao Tome and Principe,


Guided by the principles of peaceful co-existence, non-interference in internal affairs, equality, respect for sovereignty and mutual benefit,

Have decided to establish diplomatic relations at the Ambassadorial level.


This decision is to become effective as of December 25th, 1979.
