Proposal of the Mexican Delegation.

Whereas it is of paramount importance that all the members of the World Health Organization be kept informed of the work and activities of the Organization and the progress in the field of Public Health, welfare and medicine;

Whereas such information may most efficiently be carried out by means of periodical and non-periodical publications;

Whereas it is advisable that a provision for such publication be included in the Constitution of the World Health Organization;

The Mexican Delegation moves that in Chapter II, Article 3 after paragraph (d) be added the following:

(d)...to publish a Journal of the World Health Organization and other useful publications to keep informed the work of the Organization and the progress achieved in the field of Public Health, Welfare and Medicine.
