## Section VII. Executive Board

The Delegation of Paraguay considers that a category of permanent delegates should be added to the Executive Board. They would be the former Chairmen of the Conferences or Assemblies as we now call them.

They would be an important asset to the Organization, owing to their technical ability (without any doubt this is one of the important reasons they were chosen for such a high post in the first place), their very valuable experience in this kind of creative work, and their natural attachment to an institution which they themselves have headed. It would also permit a continuity in this work in both time and space.

In such a character they would not be entitled to vote.

This proposal, if approved, might be left to the Drafting Committee to work out.
