INTERNATIONAL HEALTH CONFERENCE COMMITTEE II ON ADMINISTRATION AND FINANCES

PROPOSALS CONCERNING THE FUNCTIONS OF THE ASSEMBLY SUBMITTED BY THE AUSTRALIAN DELEGATION

1. The Assembly shall determine the policy and approve the budget and financial procedures of the Organization.

2. The Assembly shall elect the members of the Board and appoint the Director-General.

3. The Assembly shall review and approve the activities of the Board and of the Director-General, and instruct the Board in regard to matters upon which action, study, investigation and report may be considered desirable.
4. The Conference may by a two-thirds majority of the votes cast make recommendations to Member States, on matters related to the functions of the Organization, for consideration with a view to their acceptance by national action.

5. The Conference may by a two-thirds majority of the votes cast submit to Members conventions on matters related to the functions of the Organization with a view to their acceptance by appropriate constitutional procedure.

6. The Conference may by two-thirds majority make recommendations to inter-governmental organizations regarding any matter pertaining to the functions of the Health Organization.
