INTERNATIONAL HEALTH CONFERENCE COMMITTEE V (REGIONAL ARRANGEMENTS) SUMMARY RECORD OF THE SECOND MEETING Held at Hunter College, 28 June 1946, at 10:00 a.m. CHAIRMAN: Dr. W. A. TIMMERMAN (Notherlands)

Paragraph 5, page 4 should reas as follows:

Dr. ZWANCK (Argentina) strongly favoured the continued existence of the Pan-American Sanitary Bureau because of its satisfactory work and long tradition of co-operation. He therefore supported and preferred the proposal of the Dolegation of the United States, while the proposals of Brazil, as well as that of the United Kingdom might also serve as basis for discussion. He believed that the Pan-American Sanitary Bureau should exist side by side with the World Health Organization, not in absolute independence, but within its limited regional scope, in complete co-operation with the Organization.
