Proposal

Marginal 220 536 (3) (b) amend to read: Intentional or unintentional stopping of the vehicle engine; in this case the heating device may be restarted manually by the driver.

Justification

The intention of this paragraph is to stop the combustion heating when the vehicle is in a filling station, should the driver forget to switch off the heating system. As the vehicle engine will be stopped during the filling operation the heating system will be switched off in any case, either by normal stopping of the vehicle engine via the ignition key or by other means, e.g. by stalling.

The wording which is used in document TRANS/WP.15/139 (intentional or accidental stopping of the vehicle engine) might serve the same purpose, however, the word "accidental" is sometimes misinterpreted as meaning "in case of an accident".
