Noting that human beings strive for a world respectful of cultures, identities and human rights and, in that regard, work to ensure that all activities, including those affected by globalization, are consistent with those aims,

<u>Recognizes</u> that while globalization, by its impact on, <u>inter alia</u>, the role of the State, may also have an impact on human rights, the promotion and protection of all human rights is first and foremost the responsibility of the State,
