Guatemala:* draft resolution

<u>Preparation of the new international development strategy</u> for the fourth United Nations development decade

The General Assembly,

Recalling its resolutions 3201 (S-VI) and 3202 (S-VI) of 1 May 1974, containing the Declaration and the Programme of Action on the Establishment of a New International Economic Order, 3281 (XXIX) of 12 December 1974, containing the Charter of Economic Rights and Duties of States, and 3362 (S-VII) of 16 September 1975 on development and international economic co-operation,

<u>Recalling also</u> its resolution 35/56 of 5 December 1980, the annex to which contains the International Development Strategy for the Third United Nations Development Decade, and its decision 40/438 of 17 December 1985 concerning the review and appraisal of the implementation of the Strategy,

<u>Gravely concerned</u> that the goals and objectives of the Strategy remain largely unfulfilled,

<u>Recognizing</u> the crucial and urgent need for the reactivation of the economic and social development process of the developing countries,

1. <u>Requests</u> the Secretary-General in consultation with all the organs and organizations of the United Nations system concerned, to collect information relevant to the formulation of a new international development strategy, which will contribute to the establishment of a new international economic order, taking fully into account the above-mentioned resolutions and the assessment of the implementation of the International Development Strategy for the Third United Nations Development Decade;

2. <u>Also requests</u> the Secretary-General to report to the General Assembly at its forty-third session, through the Economic and Social Council, on the information requested above;

3. <u>Decides</u> to consider, at its forty-third session, appropriate further action for the preparation and elaboration of an international development strategy for the fourth United Nations development decade (1991-2000).
