#### Relationship between disarmament and development

The General Assembly,

Recalling its resolutions 38/71 B of 15 December 1983, 39/160 of 17 December 1984 and 40/155 of 16 December 1985, its decision 40/473 of 20 June 1986 and its decision 41/422 of 4 December 1986,

Recalling the provisions of the Final Document of the Tenth Special Session of the General Assembly, 1/ the first special session devoted to disarmament, related to the relationship between disarmament and development,

Stressing that the holding of the International Conference on the Relationship between Disarmament and Development in New York from 24 August to 11 September 1987 constituted a significant development in the process of the multilateral review, at a political level, of the relationship between disarmament and development,

1. Welcomes the adoption of the Final Document of the International Conference on the Relationship between Disarmament and Development; 2/

2. Decides to have the report of the Conference brought to the attention of the Preparatory Committee of the third special session of the General Assembly devoted to disarmament;

3. Requests that Committee to include the consideration of an item entitled "Relationship between disarmament and development, in the light of the action programme adopted at the International Conference" in the agenda of the special session;

4. Requests the Secretary-General to take action through the appropriate organs, within available resources, for the implementation of the action programme as adopted at the International Conference.
